



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TERMS OF BUSINESS

- 50% of the total daily rates are required to secure your safari.
- Remaining 50% of the total daily rates, license fees, and additional costs required 30 days before the safari commences.
- Trophy fees and any further additional costs will be paid for in full, within 10 working days of the last day of your safari.
- All government license fee will be paid for in full before the safari commences.
- License fees and trophy fees of any animals wounded or lost will be paid for in full.

LICENSES

Certain safari costs are implemented by the government of Mozambique. These costs are mandatory for all hunters and will be billed accordingly. These costs include; hunting license per hunter per area, animal license fees per species, firearm import permit per firearm, and trophy inspections (Included in our “trophy prep and transport” cost to export company)

Client information forms will be provided for both hunters and observers to fill out and return to our head office before the safari commences. The client information form includes the following:

PROTOCOLS

McDonald Safaris and Mozambique Game Trackers conform to the laws and regulations of Mozambique and South Africa. In addition to this, we have developed our own protocols to ensure best conservation practices as well as to motivate the importation of key species into foreign countries. By embarking on a hunting safari with McDonald Safaris you accept and conform to the same protocols.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

FLIGHTS & TRANSPORT

Mozambique and South Africa have multiple flights daily into the major cities. Mozambique's major airports include Maputo, Tete and Pemba. South Africa's major airports include Johannesburg and Cape Town.

If your international flight route includes overnighting in Johannesburg we recommend contacting 'Africa Sky guest house' or 'Afton Safari Lodge' to assist with your firearms at the customs holding facility at the airport.

Additionally, Africa Sky provide quality accommodations within close proximity of the airport to ensure a quick and easy transition on to your next travels.

Upon arrival in Mozambique and South Africa you will be met by our representative who will guide you through customs and clearing your rifles.

Once completed you will be escorted to the transfer vehicle or charter aircraft.

When afield your licensed Professional Hunter will have a fully kitted 4x4 hunting vehicle, equipped with all the bells and whistles to ensure your hunting experience on safari be a comfortable one.

VISAS

Mozambique issue entry visas into the country upon arrival, however, we recommend you pre-apply for your visa through the Mozambique consulate in your home country at least 1 month before arrival.

FIREARMS

Mozambique and South Africa require a firearm import permit, per rifle, in order to bring your firearm/s into the country.

For Mozambique, our head office will pre-apply for all your firearm import permit. You will need to supply us with all your firearm documentation, proof of ownership and copy of your passport at least 2 months before your arrival.

For South Africa, our head office will put you on contact with recommended agents who specialize in firearm application permits.

ABOUT

The Moz Parks Foundation was established by likeminded role players in the safari industry with the aim of supporting the conservation efforts of hunting concession owners in Mozambique. The hands on organization is dedicated to being an operation where funds are allocated directly to the projects on the ground.

ANTI POACHING

By funding efficient and well trained anti poaching units on the ground, species in the concessions are able to maintain full capacity of the game species in the concessions; in some cases, specific species endemic only to these areas. Our projects include training of game scouts and providing the necessary facilities to conduct the day to day operations.

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

By implementing CBNRM (Community Based Recourse Management) we are able to convince local communities of the benefits of conservation, particularly in and around hunting areas. Our projects include assisting the land owners in getting 20% of the Government License fees paid to the neighboring communities.

RESEARCH

Our research initiative is a twofold application. By developing both non detrimental findings and species enhancement findings through sustainable utilizations we are able to provide the necessary information required for the importation of key species into international countries. At the same time we are able provide valuable data for the concessionaires to manage their areas through best possible conservation methods.

Our research includes, impacts of social development and anti poaching, as well as monitoring and providing enhancement findings of key species such as Lion, Elephant and Leopard

TAXIDERMY

MOZAMBIQUE

Trophies will be field prepared in camp, ready for transport to the dip and pack export agent, who will prepare them for export to your nominated taxidermist from where it is routed to the final destination you prescribe. Once your trophies are delivered to the dip and pack agent, the agent will contact you with regards to payments and shipping details required.

SOUTH AFRICA

Trophies will be field prepared in camp, ready for transport to the recommended taxidermy company in South Africa, where they will either be mounted at the taxidermy or shipped to your taxidermy of choice in your home country. We have used Splitting Image Taxidermy as well as Life Form Taxidermy for many years continuously prove to be the most efficient service providers to date. Upon receipt of the trophies, the taxidermy company will contact you with regards to payments and shipping details required.
